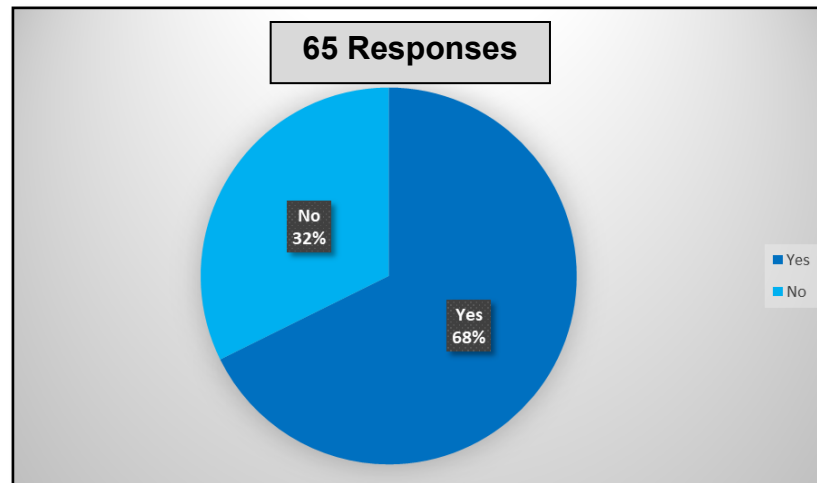


Betsie Valley District Library Expansion Survey Results

Question 1: Do you have a library card with the Betsie Valley District Library?

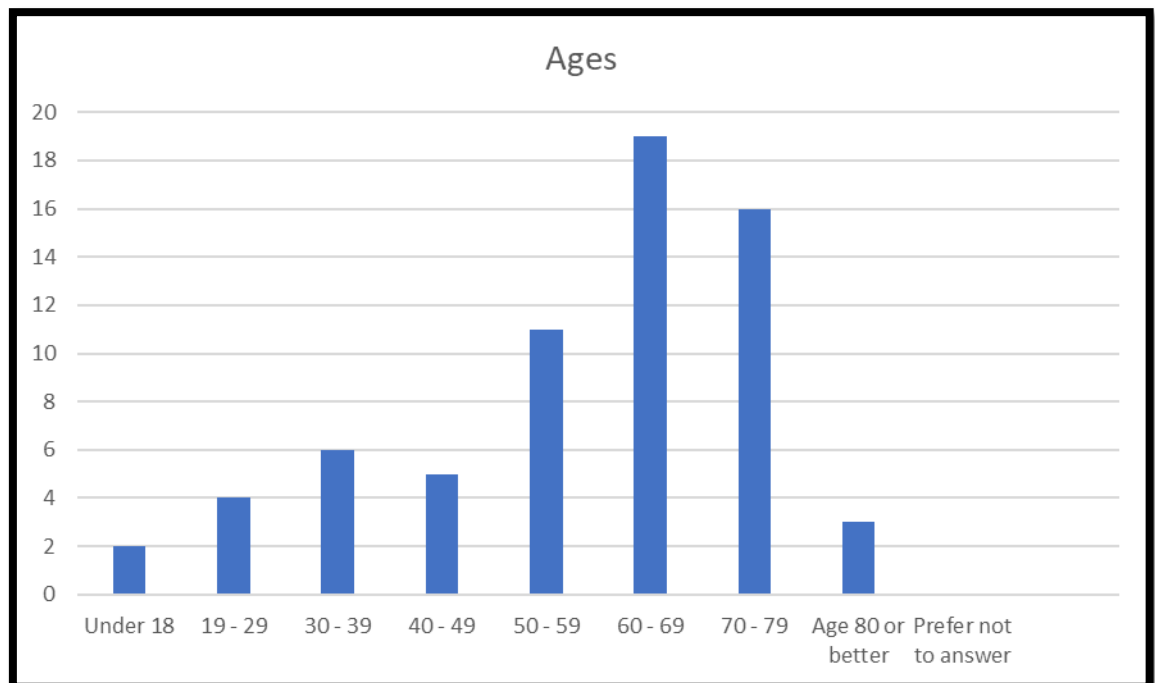

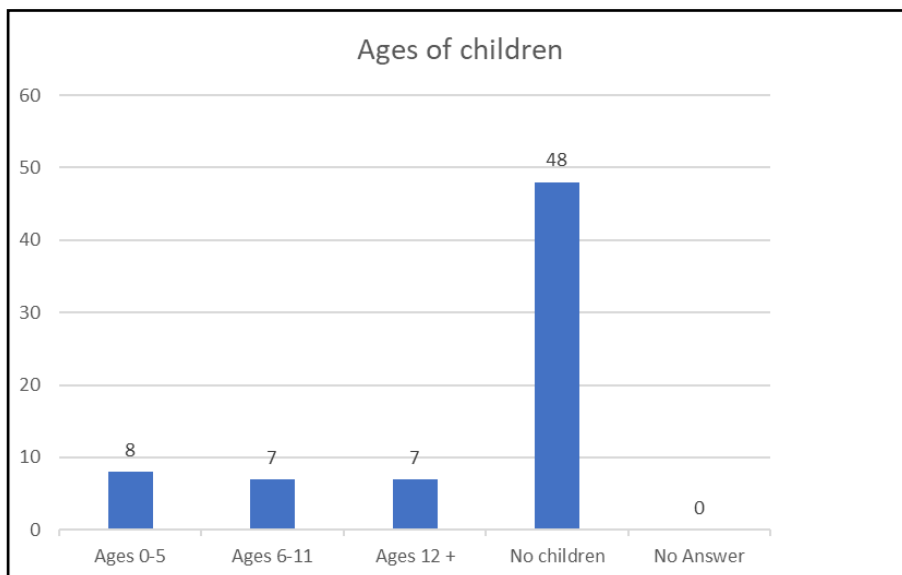

Question 3: Please let us know the ages of children living in your home. Select all that apply:

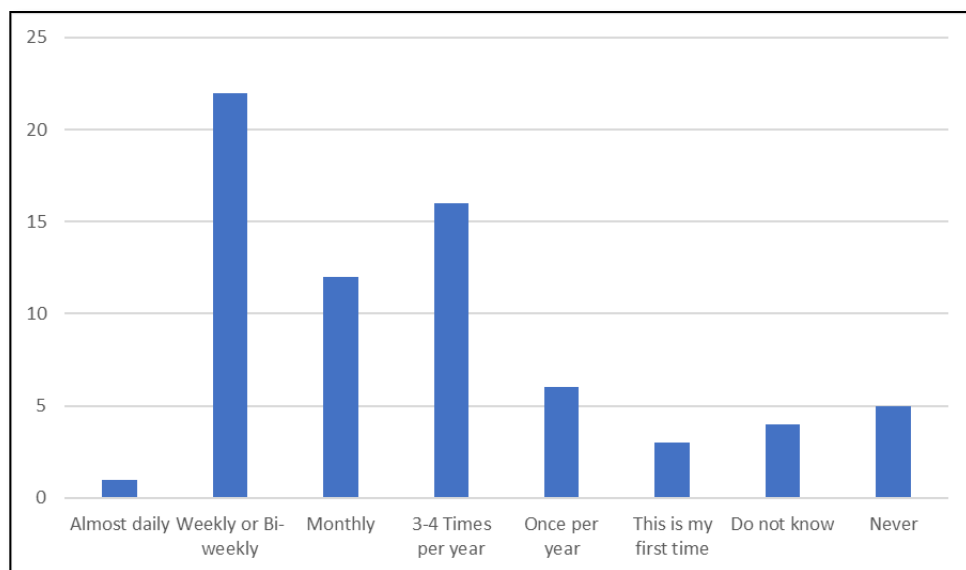

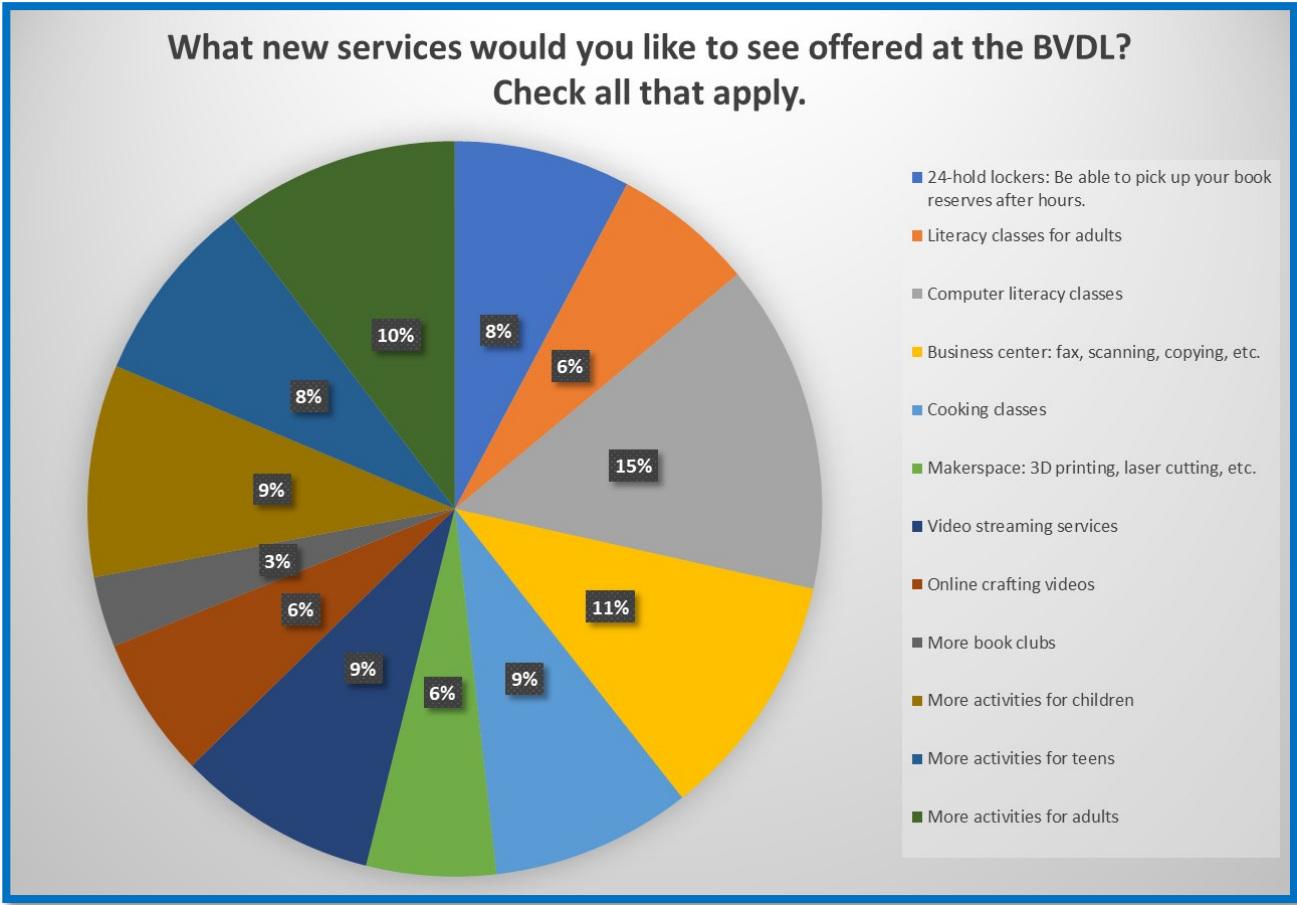

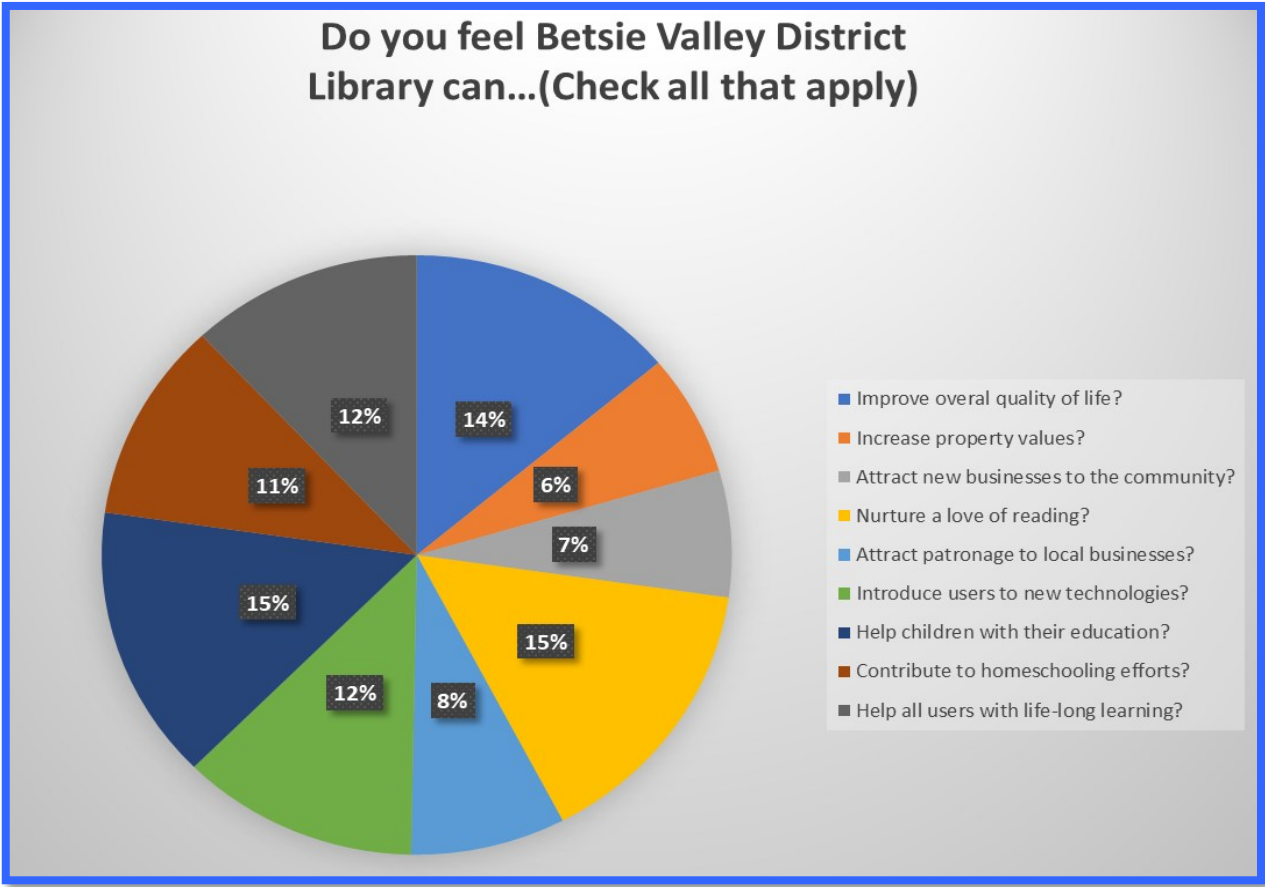
